**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNOR TO ALLOW CHIROPRACTORS AND PROVIDERS OF OTHER FORMS OF CONSERVATIVE TREATMENT TO OPERATE (AS AMENDED).**

**SPONSORED BY: SPONSORSHIP WITHDRAWN**

**WHEREAS**, for many people, chiropractors and providers of other forms of conservative treatment are the main pain management method for back and joint pain;

**WHEREAS**, many people choose chiropractors and providers of other forms of conservative treatment over narcotics for pain relief;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”) has listed chiropractors among essential critical infrastructure workers;

**WHEREAS**, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) have provided acceptable guidelines for chiropractic operations;

**WHEREAS**, the other forty-nine (49) states are allowing chiropractic help under CDC

guidelines; and

**WHEREAS,** the Chiropractic Associations of Kentucky have submitted their re-start procedures as dictated by the CDC to the Governor's Office; and

**WHEREAS,** this Resolution requires emergency consideration as authorized by Council Rule 7.01 because chiropractors and providers of other forms of conservative treatment provide essential care and needed services during a healthcare crisis.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Council asks the Governor to allow chiropractic services and other forms of conservative treatment to resume in the state of Kentucky, under acceptable CDC guidelines.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
