A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PLANNING COMMISSION REVIEW THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE REGULATIONS WITH REGARD TO HEAVY TRUCK PARKING.

## SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER NICOLE GEORGE

WHEREAS, The Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the "Council") has taken notice of issues surrounding the parking of heavy trucks; and

**WHEREAS**, Heavy truck parking is prohibited in residential areas, requiring residents who own heavy trucks to park them away from their residences; and

WHEREAS, Heavy truck parking is only permitted in a few zoning districts; and

**WHEREAS**, The limited availability of heavy truck parking in many areas leads to violation of the LDC; and

WHEREAS, Heavy truck-driven shipping is an integral part of the Louisville economy; and

**WHEREAS**, There are multiple potential options to address this apparent shortage, including expanding the zones where heavy truck parking is allowed by right, permitting heavy truck parking in

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new zones with standards, and/or permitti	ng heavy truck parking in new zones with a Conditional
Use Permit;
