BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from District 19 Neighborhood

Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the City of Middletown to

provide ~~needed safety equipment for the Middletown Police Department~~ mobile radio upgrades and ballistic helmets with face shields for the Middletown Police Department.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
