BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from District 1 Neighborhood Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Fuller Center for Housing of Louisville to assist with the #STRIVEFORFIVEPARKLAND project which provides permanent and affordable housing for the most economically marginalized families.
