NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the Reverend Allen Evans, Jr.'s service to Louisville Metro be honored with an honorary street sign on the southwest corner of 22nd and West Madison Street in Louisville, Kentucky, designated as "Rev. Allen Evans, Jr. Drive." The Department of Public Works is hereby directed to move forward with fabrication and installation of the honorary street sign upon the passage of this Resolution and the receipt of funds to cover the expense.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
