AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 101, SERIES 2016 AND ORDINANCE NO. 102, SERIES 2016 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS, RESPECTIVLY, BY TRANSFERRING \$864,800 FROM DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY OPERATING FUND TO DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY CAPITAL FUND RELATED TO TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS. (AS AMENDED)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:
