ORDINANCE NO, SERIES 2018 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FROM DISTRICT 24 NEIGHBORHOO DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT, 7 DIVISION, TO FUND OVERTIME EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH CRIM REDUCTION, CRIME PREVENTION, AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH. SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER FLOOD
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METR GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION I: The amount of \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from District 24 Neighborhood Development Funds to the
Louisville Metro Police Department, 7 th Division, to fund overtime expenses associated with crime reduction, crin
prevention, and community outreach.
SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date
passage of this Ordinance.
SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
