WHEREAS, none of the contracts contains an award of work; any such award, if any, shall occur based on award of work to the lowest and best evaluated quotation for each job; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor described in this Resolution has been selected as one of the prequalified contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, KRS Chapter 45A and KRS 67C.105(5)(j) require Metro Council approval of each such contract.
