ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2019 AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING FROM OR-2 OFFICE/RESIDENTIAL AND M-3 INDUSTRIAL TO C-2 COMMERCIAL ON PROPERTIES LOCATED AT 709/715 EAST GRAY STREET, 710, 712, AND 716 EAST CHESTNUT STREET, AND 616-634 SOUTH SHELBY STREET CONTAINING 2.41 ACRES AND BEING IN LOUISVILLE METRO (CASE NO. 18ZONE1052). WHEREAS, The Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the

"Council") has considered the evidence presented at the public hearing held by the Louisville Metro

Planning Commission and the recommendations of the Planning Commission and its staff as set out

in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18ZONE1052; and

WHEREAS, the Council concurs in and adopts the findings of the Planning Commission for

the zoning change in Case No. 18ZONE1052 and approves and accepts the recommendations of the

Planning Commission as set out in said minutes and records;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the zoning of the properties located at 709/715 East Gray Street, 710, 712, and 716 East Chestnut Street, and 616-634 South Shelby Street containing 2.41 acres and being in Louisville Metro, as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18ZONE1052, is hereby changed from OR-2 Office/Residential and M-3 Industrial to C-2 Commercial; provided, however, said property shall be subject to the binding elements as set forth in the minutes of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18ZONE1052.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
