**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_, SERIES 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FROM DISTRICT 26 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT, 6<sup>TH</sup> DIVISION, TO ADDRESS CRIME CONCERNS AND TRENDS AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION MAJOR IN AN AREA GENERALLY ALONG HIKES LANE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The amount of \$15,000 is hereby appropriated from District 26 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department, 6<sup>th</sup> Division, to address crime concerns and trends as determined by the Division Major in an area generally along Hikes Lane.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
