# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The amount of \$9,500 is hereby appropriated from the District 19 Neighborhood

Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the City of Middletown

Kentucky Police Department for the purchase of a speed alert system.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended

for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective

at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
