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| ORDINANCE NO, SERIES 2020 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 073, SERIES 2020 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT BY APPROPRIATING \$10,000,000 OF GENERAL FUND COMMITTED FUND BALANCE FROM FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 TO THE OFFICE OF RESILIENCE & COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR UTILITY ASSISTANCE GRANTS. SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS HOLLANDER, WINKLER, DORSEY, SHANKLIN, AND FOWLER |
| WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a devastating effect on the health of Louisville |
| Metro residents; and |
| WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused an economic recession that has widely |
| affected the personal finances of many Louisville Metro residents; and |
| WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to maintain Louisville Metro residents' access to such |
| vital services as water, sewer, and gas & electric utilities; and |
| WHEREAS, it is appropriate to provide grant relief to such residents for both their financial and |
| health concerns to benefit the entirety of the community by slowing the spread of the virus. |
| NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS: |
