RESOLUTION HONORING GE APPLIANCES, A HAIER COMPANY, BY DEDICATING AN ACCESS DRIVE NEAR BUECHEL BANK ROAD AND POPLAR LEVEL ROAD AS "GE WAY" IN RECOGNITION OF THE 5<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE U.S. CORPORATE HEADQUARTERS OF GE APPLICANCES, A HAIER COMPANY, IN APPLIANCE PARK.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** In recognition of GEA's continued commitment to Louisville Metro, GEA shall be honored with an honorary street sign in Appliance Park, near Buechel Bank Road and Popular Level Road, in Louisville, Kentucky, to be designated as "GEA Way." The Department of Public Works is hereby directed to move forward with fabrication and installation of the honorary street sign upon the passage of the resolution. GEA, having agreed to provide funding for the signage, shall coordinate payment with the Department of Public Works to cover the expense.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
