RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT (JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023) RELATING TO WAGES, AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT HOURS. AND TERMS LOUISVILLE METRO **GOVERNMENT** AND THE INDIANA/KENTUCKY/OHIO OF REGIONAL COUNCIL **CARPENTERS** ("IKORCC"). WHICH THE SUCCESSOR TO THE CARPENTERS INDUSTRIAL COUNCIL FOR EMPLOYEES DEPARTMENT, DEVELOP LOUISVILLE AND CODES AND REGULATIONS SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES DIVISION.

WHEREAS, a Collective Bargaining Agreement has been reached between the Louisville Metro Government and the Indiana/Kentucky/Ohio Regional Council of Carpenters ("IKORCC"), which is the successor to the Carpenters Industrial Council for and on behalf of employees of Codes and Regulations Department, Develop Louisville and Solid Waste Management Services Division; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to extend the terms contained in the prior Collective Bargaining Agreement (July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2021) except as provided in their Memorandum of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the prior Collective Bargaining Agreement and the Memorandum of Agreement are collectively referred to the "Collective Bargaining Agreement (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023)."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I.** The Collective Bargaining Agreement (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023) reached between Louisville Metro Government and the Indiana/Kentucky/Ohio Regional Council of
