AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING **\$21.000** \$25.500 FROM **NEIGHBORHOOD** DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$3,000 FROM DISTRICT 6; \$1,875 FROM DISTRICT 15; \$1,500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 2, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 17, 19, AND 26; \$750 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 20, 22, 23, AND 24; AND \$375 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 13. 21. AND 25: THROUGH THE OFFICE OF SHAKESPEARE, MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, то KENTUCKY INC. FOR PERFORMANCES OF KENTUCKY SHAKESPEARE'S HAMLET IN PARKS IN LOUISVILLE METRO (AS AMENDED). BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$21,000 \$25,500 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood

Development Funds in the following manner: <u>\$3,000 from District 6;</u> \$1,875 from District 15; \$1,500

each from Districts 2, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 17, 19, and 26; \$750 each from Districts 20, 22, 23, and

24; and \$375 each from Districts 13, 21, and 25; through the Office of Management and Budget, to

Kentucky Shakespeare, Inc. for performances of Kentucky Shakespeare's Hamlet in parks in

Louisville Metro.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and

effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
