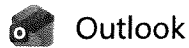

The estimate for the RRFB equipment came in at \$14,751.00. Slightly cheaper than the previous Cannons Ln purchase due to a recent contract update. Same as Cannons Ln, this includes two pairs of RRFB assemblies. So we're looking at a total of \$19,501.

KYTC mentioned that they were preparing a RRFB quote for you at the following location of Lexington and Wentworth. The concrete work needed to install a RRFB post on side of the crosswalk would be **\$4,750**. That would include a Mob charge, MOT requirements and some new concrete with the bolts for the RRFB to be set on top of. This would be very similar to what we did on Cannons Lane. The cost of the RRFB equipment is not part of this price.
