AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$3,000~~ \$5,250 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$3,000 FROM DISTRICT 9; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 7 AND 26; AND \$250 FROM DISTRICT 8; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO ST. MATTHEWS FIRE AND RESCUE BENEVOLENCE FUND CORPORATION FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ITS FIRST ANNUAL FREEDOM FEST TO BE HELD JULY 3, 2026 (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$3,000~~ \$5,250 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development funds in the following manner: \$3,000 from District 9; \$1,000 each from Districts 7 and 26; and \$250 from District 8; through the Office of Management and Budget, to St. Matthews Fire and Rescue Benevolence Fund Corporation for costs associated with its first annual Freedom Fest to be held July 3, 2026.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
