 - Led congregation to purchase a new church campus, completing a \$5 million renovation.
 - Led the construction and completion of a \$3 Million Dollar Youth Facility, 2026.
 - Led and oversaw a complete sanctuary and educational space renovation, 2021.
 - Led the construction of a \$1.7 Millions Dollar parking lot, 2017.

 - Oversaw the transition from a volunteer only model to a staff-led church model.
