The funding will directly support violence prevention, mentorship, educational exposure, cultural enrichment, wellness programming, leadership development, and structured youth engagement opportunities for underserved youth throughout Parkland, Park DuValle, Algonquin, and surrounding West Louisville communities.

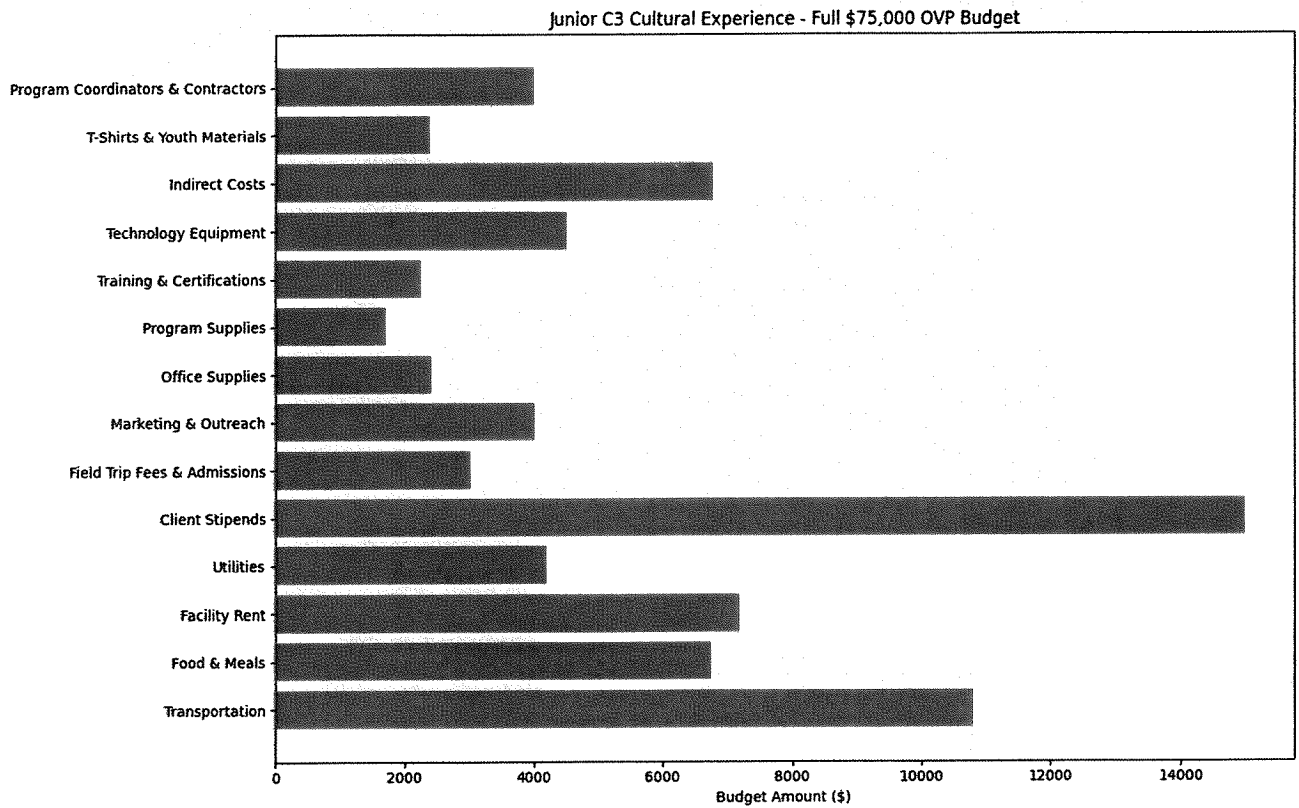

### Program Benefits & Violence Prevention Impact

- Provides structured alternatives to crime and negative peer influence.
- Expands youth access to educational, cultural, and career exploration opportunities.
- Builds self-confidence, identity, leadership skills, and resilience.
- Strengthens community pride, civic engagement, and neighborhood participation.
- Connects youth with positive adult mentors and public safety professionals.
- Promotes wellness, teamwork, responsibility, and healthy recreation.
- Reduces transportation and economic barriers that prevent youth participation.

### Expected Outcomes

1. 75% of participants will identify at least one new educational or career goal.
2. 80% of youth will report increased confidence and self-efficacy.
3. 70% of participants will demonstrate improved conflict resolution and decision-making skills.
4. 90% attendance rate will be maintained across monthly programming activities.
5. 75% of youth will complete at least one hands-on project or community service activity.

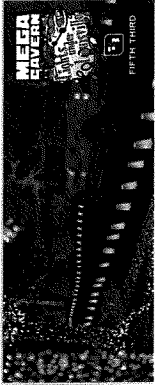

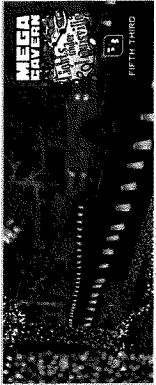

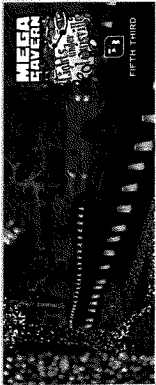
